**Speaker Biography: Martine A. Rothblatt**

Dr. Martine A. Rothblatt founded United Therapeutics Corporation in 1996, and serves as its Chief Executive Officer. She also serves as the Chairman, President, and Chief Executive Officer of Lung Rx Inc. (also known as Lung LLC).

Prior to founding United Therapeutics, Dr. Rothblatt founded and served as Chief Executive Officer of Sirius Satellite Radio, co-founded and served as Chief Operating Officer of satellite sound broadcasting pioneer WorldSpace Corp. and was principally responsible for several other unique applications of satellite communications technology. She also represented the radio astronomy interests of the National Academy of Sciences Committee on Radio Frequencies before the FCC, and led the International Bar Associations efforts to present the United Nations with a draft Human Genome Treaty.

Dr. Rothblatt is a member of the Committee on Science, Technology, and Law of the National Academy of Sciences. She also serves as Director of Synthetic Genomics, Inc. and President of the William Harvey Medical Research Foundation. She is past-Chairman of the Law and Medicine Committee of the International Bar Association.

Dr. Rothblatt graduated from UCLA with a combined law and MBA degree in 1981 and received her Ph.D. in Medical Ethics in 2001 from University of London.
